Express entries must have signature release. All entries with fees, (U.S. funds) made out to Papillon Club of Southern California (PCSC) must be received by the Show Secretary by:

6:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28, 2012

after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

Entries – Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, a bitch in season, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

Faxed Entries – To fax an entry, use PayPal services, payable to account for PARRKEES@mac.com. Add \$4.00 for each entry form to the correct entry fee amount. Fax number is (760) 946-9048. You must fax the front and back of entry form for it to be accepted, completely filled out and signed. Notification must be received by the show secretary from PayPal that the funds have been deposited before the entry will be accepted.

Health of Dogs – Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AKC Recording Fee, Event Service Fee and Rally Recording Fee – Collected by the club and paid to the American Kennel Club, a recording fee and event service fee are required for each dog entered at this show. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fees are collected on the first entry only. The exception is Rally, where the recording fee is collected for each class entry of each dog. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows Chapter 11, Section 2, and Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 3).

Entry Acknowledgement – If an exhibitor's ticket and judging program are not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Show Secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult the judging program for time of judging. If it is desired that an agent receive a judging program and copy of exhibitor's ticket, include name and address with a request to do so.

Judging – The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The club and its show secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to notify exhibitors or their agents of class judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Judges will not hold up a class by waiting for any dog.

AKC Rules and Regulations – Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, P.O. Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.

Loss or Damage – The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators participating in this show. By entering this show the owner, exhibitor or handler agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the PCSC, its members, officers and board of directors against claims or damages arising out of the conduct of any exhibitor and/or their dog or dogs. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.

Grooming and Clean-up – Grooming tables, pens or exhibitor set-ups may only be in areas specified by the club. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in and around their set-up. Clean up after your own dogs, and notify the show committee if others fail to do same.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Best of Breed – Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the Championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its Championship has been confirmed by the A.K.C.

AWARDS OF MERIT

At the judge's discretion, awarded to 10 percent of entrants in Best of Breed Competition.

Obedience Trials Classification (BOTH DAYS)

There will be one obedience trial limited to 50 entries each day. All Papillon entries will be accepted first. All other breeds will be accepted on a first received basis. The regular classes including Novice A & B, Open A & B and Utility A & B have first priority, followed by optional titling classes Beginning Novice A & B, Graduate Open and Versatility. Papillons will be judged with other breeds, going first in each class, followed by all other breeds in ascending height order Saturday and descending height order Sunday. Move-ups will be allowed and must be made one-half-hour prior to the start of the trial (4/2012)

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND/OR THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
